APPLICATION OF THE UNIT

This unit describes a participant's skills and knowledge required to conduct civil construction wheeled front end loader operations in Civil construction. PREREQUISITE REQUIREMENTS

DELIVERY OF TRAINING

The nominal hours for this unit of competency is 160 hours. For a participant to be deemed competent in this unit, there will be a requirement for a log book to be issued and duties to be performed outside of the Registered Training Organisation so that on the job work experience/duties can be performed and hours logged before a practical assessment can be undertaken.

Training is delivered over a two day period for both theory and practical components through a face to face classroom environment and practical experience in a supervised outdoor environment. Upon successful completion of this unit, participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment and a Photo ID Card.
