COURSE OBJECTIVE

This unit specifies the outcomes required to operate a vehicle loading crane with a capacity of 10 metre tonnes or more, mounted on a vehicle for the principle purpose of loading and unloading such a vehicle, including the application of load estimation and slinging techniques to move a load, for licensing purposes.

PREREQUISITE REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must be 18 or older and able to speak and understand the English Language.
- Applicants must have at least a year 10 mathematical ability for working out calculations
- Protective footwear must be worn for commencement into the course.

APPLICATION OF THE UNIT

This unit requires the operator to plan the work, conduct routine checks, set up crane, transfer loads and shut down and secure crane. This unit is based on the requirements of the National Standard for Licensing Persons Performing High Risk Work. This unit in its current form meets state and territory licensing requirements.

DELIVERY OF TRAINING

Training is delivered over a four - five day period including WorkCover Assessment and covers both theory and practical components through a face to face classroom environment and practical experience in a supervised outdoor environment. Upon successful completion of this unit, participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment and a WorkCover NSW Card.
