TLILIC2001 LICENCE TO OPERATE A FORKLIFT TRUCK

COURSE OBJECTIVE

This unit specifies the skills and knowledge required to operate a forklift truck safely. Forklift truck means a powered industrial truck equipped with lifting media made up of a mast and an elevating load carriage to which is attached a pair of fork arms or other arms that can be raised 900 mm or more above the ground, but does not include a pedestrian-operated truck or a pallet truck. A person performing this work is required to hold a forklift truck high risk work (HRW) licence.

PREREQUISITE REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must be 18 or older and able to speak and understand the English Language.
- Applicants must have at least a year 10 mathematical ability for working out calculations
- Protective footwear must be worn for commencement into the course.

APPLICATION OF THE UNIT

This unit requires a person operating a forklift truck to plan the work, conduct routine checks on a forklift truck, shift loads in a safe manner, and safely shut down and secure equipment after completing operations

This unit is based on the licensing requirements of Part 4.5 of the Model Work Health and Safety (WHS) Regulations, HRW and meets Commonwealth, state and territory HRW licensing requirements.

DELIVERY OF TRAINING

Training is delivered over a three day period including both theory and practical components through a face to face classroom environment and practical experience in a supervised outdoor environment. Upon successful completion of this unit, participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment and a WorkCover NSW Card.
